GOAL FOR THE WEEK

DIVING DEEPER

Why does the fact that God is unchanging, mean that the people of God will not be destroyed? How does this truth apply to us and our salvation? (Malachi 3:6)

Are God's purposes for your life clear to you? How can we practically take hold of God's hope every day so that we may live as greatly encouraged? (Hebrews 6:17-18)

What are the good and perfect gifts that God has given you and how do they point to God's unchanging nature? How can the truths of these verses move you to gratitude, regardless of your circumstances? (James 1:17)

Read Hebrews 13:8. In your own words, describe what this verse means. How can the hope from this verse impact you when you run into struggles?
