GOAL FOR THE WEEK

To grow in an understanding of God's Holiness, resulting in an awareness of sin that leads to gratitude.

What is something in your life that is sacred and precious to you?

Define Holy- What is it and what does it mean?

Why does it matter that God is Holy?

How does the Holiness of God make you feel? Why can God's Holiness be scary? Why is it good?

How do you view your own self in view of God's Holiness? What is your response to that view?

Repenting of sin and being in awe of God's grace are the outcome of His Holiness. What does that look like for you?



DIVING DEEPER

Why do you think in Revelation 4:8 the angels sing Holy three times in describing God?

Why does Moses turn away from the burning bush when he first encounters it in Exodus 3:1-6?

Read Isaiah 6 and describe Isaiah's progression as he encounters God's presence and sees His Holiness.

What does it mean to walk in Holiness? Can we even do that? (1 Peter 1:15)

If Holiness means set apart, how are we supposed to do that and yet still live in this world?

HOMEWORK: Read and meditate on 1 Peter 1:13-25 every day.

PRAYER

Praise God for His Holiness and that He gives us Jesus who in turns makes us Holy before Him.
