## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

### DIVING DEEPER

Read Colossians 1:16-17. Write out how each of God's attributes are shown in the text.

Read John 1:1-5 side by side with Genesis 1:1-5. Write out all the similarities you find.

Read Romans 8:22-23, what does it mean that Creation groans and what are examples of science showing the chaos of the fallen natural world?

**HOMEWORK:** Pick a book, video, article, or have an experience from the resource page and discuss it as a group. Spend an hour in creation. What does creation tell you about God?
