DIVING DEEPER

Read Job 1:6-12. Discuss how God's sovereignty is on display in His interactions with Satan

Read Genesis 3. Discuss how does God respond to the sin that has been committed and the evil done by satan.

Read Romans 8:20-21. Discuss specific areas in which creation feels the effects of evil in the world. How has creation been affected by mankind's evil?

Read John 1:1-5. Discuss how the light overcomes the darkness today and how light will overcome darkness for all eternity.

HOMEWORK: *Pray for the persecuted church specifically every day. Visit the Voice of the Martyrs website and pray for a specific people group.*
