MAKE DISCIPLES

WHAT IS IT?

What is a disciple? A disciple is a follower, or learner of Jesus. Jesus asked people to follow Him, go with Him, learn from Him, watch Him, live like Him, and to teach others to do the same.



BIBLE STORY JESUS CALLS HIS FIRST DISCIPLES

As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. “Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.” At once they left their nets and followed him.

DISCUSSION

Read the Bible story and then review

1. In whose name did Jesus tell his disciples to baptize others?
2. What one work describes these names?
3. What did Jesus tell His disciples to teach people?
4. What did Jesus promise His disciples?
5. What did the disciples have to drop and leave behind to follow Jesus?
6. Imagine you are in school one day and Jesus walked in – what would he tell you to drop?
7. What would Jesus say to your teachers? Your parents?
8. Why does Jesus need us to help him “catch people”?
9. What is Jesus catching people for?
10. What is the “bait” that attracts people to Jesus?
11. Do you want to be caught?
12. How are you included in Jesus command “Come follow me.”?

LIFE APPLICATION

Talk to kids about when they go to school and their teacher gives them books that they need to learn the subjects for the year. They have the tools they need to successfully learn and to be able to share that knowledge with others. Jesus equips those he calls to follow Him. Disciples are motivated, excited and curious to see how He will use us to call others to Him.
